1. Please note that our next Board meeting is November 14th at 4:00 p.m. Meeting place is: The Church of God, 1023 David Ave., P.G., Calif.

<u>Directions</u>: At the Church on David Ave. you may park in the lower parking area in front of the Church. To access the meeting room please walk to the left of the church and behind. You will find a rear door entrance where the meeting is held. Or you may park in the upper parking lot. To access it: From David Ave. turn on Presidio then on Lincoln. You will see the parking lot to the right.

- 2. Remember to please refer to the C C & R's and the Parking rules. Each townhome has a 2 car garage. If you are unable to park your cars in your garage, please park outside of the gate. The guest parking is limited and only for the use of guests for a limited period of time.
- 3. The HOA is having the algae removed from the lake on a regular basis.

- 5. The HOA has voted to have a new electronic gate access system (probably after the 1_{st} of the year). More details to follow. Each household will be provided 2 gate remotes free of charge. If you need more, you will need to purchase them from Regency.
- 6. We have had complaints of residents who walk their dogs in The Glen and Glen Heights not picking up their dog's waste. Please remember to always walk your dogs with waste bags and pick up after your dog.
- 7. On a lighter note, you will notice new lighted reindeer at our entrance this holiday season. The prior reindeer had broken leg issues and could no longer stand. (Thanks to Patti Munoz!)
- 8. And if you are wondering....we have new mail carriers. Our route is now passed around to different carriers who deliver our mail after they are done with their own, or perhaps before they start theirs. This makes our delivery different each day...and often later than we are used to.
