Nomenclature for "sewer inspec access" spreadsheet.

There are 2 groups of sewer accesses, one is under a grate in the driveway of most 2 story units, the other is in the dirt either besides the driveway of the 2 story units or in the dirt near the junction of the wall between a one story unit and the neighboring 2 story unit. (It is may be the case that all 2 story units have a second clean out in the garage floor, near the inner wall.)

Meaning of heading of each column of the table.

* <u>UNIT</u> = street number of the Unit in the complex

* $\underline{1}$ = one story units are marked with the symbol ' # '

* **<u>STATUS</u>** = Three entries appear;

unknown - location not know at this time,

Driveway - the inspection access in in the driveway and visible . no further entry is needed,

mapped - the location of the inspection access cover is specified in inches from two points for one story units or for 2 story units from the wall when access is in dirt beside driveway

* <u>START POINT</u> = a description of where the inspection access was found, or for the driveway located inspection access gratings are they on the left or right side of the driveway (as viewed from the street)

* **<u>FROM</u>; <u>THE WALL</u>** = measured from the concrete wall of the unit toward the street

* **FROM; THE CORNER** = 1 story units measured from the point where the concrete of 1 and 2 story units meet (it is usually under the window nearest the corner), 2 story units - *left or right of driveway* (usually beside the driveway)
